RE: Docket No: 21-00041 – Notification of Transfer of Control of Alliance Global Networks, LLC to Velocity

The agency received a letter on March 30, 2021 that was assigned to TPUC Docket 21-00041. The letter describes a transaction where control of Alliance Global Networks, LLC (“Alliance”) will be transferred to Velocity, A Managed Services Company, Inc. (“Velocity”).<sup>1</sup>

Alliance elected market regulation via a letter filed April 26, 2021 that was assigned to TPUC docket number 21-00050. Velocity elected market regulation via a filed April 26, 2021 that was assigned to TPUC docket number 21-00051. T.C.A. § 65-5-109(n) provides a description of the regulatory requirements that apply to companies that elect Market Regulation. The transaction, as described, is governed by T.C.A. 65-4-113 which is not a regulatory requirement that applies to companies that have elected Market Regulation. As such, the transaction described in the correspondence dated March 30, 2021 does not require approval. As no action is required by the agency, please close the above referenced docket.
