The undersigned, pursuant to Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 19(d), hereby moves the Tennessee Public Utility Commission ("Commission") for permission to appear *pro hac vice* on behalf of the Consumer Advocate Unit of the Financial Division of the Office of the Tennessee Attorney General ("Consumer Advocate") in the above-captioned docket. In support of this motion, movant respectfully shows unto the Commission, as follows:

1. Ms. Bowen is a licensed attorney in the States of Florida and North Carolina, is a member of the Bars of such States in good standing and is authorized to practice before the North Carolina and the Florida Supreme Courts.

2. Ms. Bowen is in good standing in all jurisdictions and courts where Ms. Bowen is authorized or has been permitted to practice law.

3. Ms. Bowen is employed by the Office of the Tennessee Attorney General and serves as Counsel for the Consumer Advocate Unit. She has been assigned to represent the interests of the Consumer Advocate Unit in the above captioned proceeding.



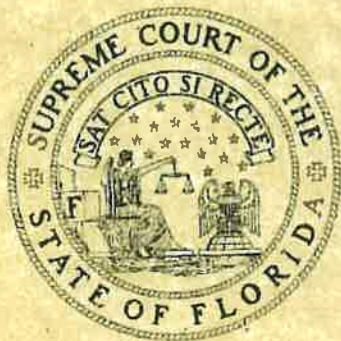
