On December 14, 2021, the Consumer Advocate Unit in the Financial Division of the office of the Tennessee Attorney General (“Consumer Advocate”) filed a letter in the docket file regarding the responses of Limestone Water Utility Operating Company, LLC (“Limestone”) to the September 4, 2021, Consumer Advocate Minimum Filing Guidelines Review Letter. The Consumer Advocate states Limestone’s response does not address the requirements for a public utility’s application for acquisition, nor have documents for the proposed acquisition been filed in compliance with Commission Rule 1220-04-14-.08.
