

As a 23 year resident of Candlewood Lakes in Hardeman County, I have a keen interest in the above referenced transaction. I'm in favor of the sale of Candlewood Lakes POA Water Works to Limestone Resources. My concern rests on the \$40.00 per month non-metered water fee. Previously, residents voted to voluntarily raise the monthly water fee from \$25.00 per month to \$40.00 in order for our leadership to investigate digging a backup water well, and/or applying for a grant from the State of Tennessee to offset some costs. When our POA Board could or would not find a reasonable contractor to dig the well and they failed to satisfy the State's request for financial records, we lost any chance to receive assistance from outside our community. At that point, I, and others feel that the monthly water rate should have been reduced back to \$25.00 per month. As it was not, I would like Limestone Resources to consider lowering the monthly water fee to \$25.00, until they install meters to bill by usage.
