RE-NOTICE OF HEARING AND FILING OF PRE-FILED TESTIMONY

IN RE: *Application of Limestone Water Utility Operating Company, LLC for Authority to Purchase Title to the Assets, Property, and Real Estate of a Water System, Candlewood Lakes, and for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity*

On February 13, 2023, the Petitioner, Limestone Water Utility Operating Company, LLC (Limestone) filed a *Motion to Change the Date of the Hearing and to Change the Date of Filing of Pre-filed Testimony*. Upon good cause shown in Limestone's *Motion*, the hearing in the above-captioned matter has been re-scheduled to be convened during the Commission Conference on **March 20, 2023**, starting at **10:00 a.m.** in the Tennessee Room on the 3rd floor of the William R. Snodgrass Tennessee Tower State Office Building located at 312 Rosa Parks Avenue, Nashville, Tennessee 37243.

The hearing will be conducted in accordance with the Tennessee Uniform Administrative Procedures Act, Tenn. Code Ann. § 4-5-101 *et seq.* Chairman Herbert H. Hilliard, Commissioner Robin L. Morrison, Commissioner Clay R. Good, Commissioner Kenneth C. Hill, and Commissioner John Hie, the voting panel, will conduct the hearing and may deliberate the merits of Limestone's petition for reconsideration filed in the docket file on January 20, 2023.

In addition, Limestone is hereby directed to file with the Commission the pre-filed sworn testimony of witness(es) who will appear and testify at the hearing no later than **2:00 p.m.** on **Monday, March 6, 2023**. Any motion to change the date of this hearing or the date of filing of pre-filed testimony must be made in writing and filed with the Commission no later than **2:00 p.m.** on **Wednesday, March 15, 2023**. All parties are entitled to be represented by counsel.
