ORDER ESTABLISHING AMENDED PARTIAL PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This matter is before the Hearing Officer of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“Commission” or “TPUC”) to establish an amended partial procedural schedule for the orderly administration of these proceedings. The Procedural Schedule established in this matter on September 8, 2021, was suspended by the Hearing Officer to allow time for discovery disputes to be resolved. Although the parties are still in the discovery process and additional disputes may arise, the Hearing Officer finds it is necessary to issue a partial amended procedural schedule to continue to efficiently move the proceedings forward to a hearing and final conclusion on the merits. Nevertheless, a procedural schedule’s effectiveness directly depends on cooperation by the parties in meeting the individual benchmark dates. The Hearing Officer hereby establishes the Amended Partial Procedural Schedule set forth in Exhibit A attached to this Order.
