ORDER GRANTING, IN PART, MOTION TO AMEND THE AMENDED PROTECTIVE  
ORDER

This matter is before the Hearing Officer of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“Commission” or “TPUC”) on the *Motion to Amend the Amended Protective Order by Tennessee Electric Cooperative Association* (“*Motion*”) filed by Tennessee Electric Cooperative Association (“TECA”) on April 1, 2022. The *Motion* requests amendments to the Amended Protective Order to address concerns raised by Northern Reliability, Inc., a third-party served with a subpoena for the production of documents. None of the other parties opposed amending the Amended Protective Order. The Hearing Officer finds that the concerns expressed by Northern Reliability, Inc. are well founded and should be addressed, however, the Hearing Officer may not address the concerns in the exact manner suggested in the *Motion*. Therefore, the *Motion* should be **GRANTED, IN PART**.
