ORDER ON NOVEMBER 8, 2022 STATUS CONFERENCE

This matter came before the Hearing Officer of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“Commission” or “TPUC”) during a telephone Status Conference held on November 8, 2022, to discuss the progression of the docket. During the Status Conference, the Hearing Officer issued a verbal ruling on the Motions to Compel filed by Tennessee Electric Cooperative Association (“TECA”) and Jackson Energy Authority (“JEA”) and stated a written order would follow.¹ The Hearing Officer granted, in part and denied, in part the Motions to Compel filed by TECA and JEA. As part of the ruling, the Hearing Officer ordered Jackson Sustainability Corporation (“JSC”) to pay to TECA and JEA reasonable attorney’s fees and expenses associated with the filing of the Motions to Compel. By agreement, the parties established the following dates:

November 23, 2022 Filing of Attorney’s fees by TECA and JEA

December 12, 2022 JSC to file objections to specific fees submitted by TECA and JEA
