Oral arguments on the *Motion for Interlocutory Appeal to the Full Public Utility Commission* filed by Jackson Sustainability Cooperative ("JSC") on December 12, 2023 are scheduled to be held during the February 27, 2023 Commission Conference beginning at 10:00 a.m. (CST). The following procedure has been established for the oral arguments:

- JSC will be given 30 minutes to present its argument, and a portion of that time may be reserved for rebuttal. JSC should inform the presiding Commissioner how much time it would like to reserve before beginning its presentation.
- The Tennessee Electric Cooperative Association, Jackson Energy Authority ("JEA"), and the Tennessee Valley Authority ("TVA") (collectively, the "Intervenors") will be allowed a **total of 30 minutes** to present their arguments. The Intervenors may determine how they will divide the allotted thirty minutes.
- The oral arguments will be presented in the following order:
 - 1) JSC
 - 2) The Intervenors:
 - a) TECA
 - b) JEA
 - c) TVA
 - 3) JSC (if time reserved for rebuttal)
