ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF THROUGH JULY 13, 2021

This matter is before the Hearing Officer appointed by the voting panel of Commissioners of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“Commission” or “TPUC”) and designated by General Counsel to administer certain preliminary issues that may arise during the preparation of this matter for hearing before the Commission. On June 14, 2021, Chattanooga Gas Company (“CGC”) filed *Chattanooga Gas Company Petition for Approval of Tariff Amendments to its Asset Management Tariff* (“*Petition*”), along with the proposed tariff.

Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-5-103(a) permits the Commission, pending a hearing and determination, to suspend any rate increase, change, or alteration for an initial period not to exceed three months from the proposed effective date of such increase, change, or alteration.¹ Because the Commission’s investigation, hearing, and final determination on the Company’s proposed tariff cannot be completed prior to the effective date of June 21, 2021, the Hearing Officer hereby suspends the effectiveness of the tariff through July 13, 2021.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

The effective date of the proposed TPUC No. 1, Third Revised Sheet No. 56 filed by

Chattanooga Gas Company on June 14, 2021, is hereby suspended through July 13, 2021, or until further order of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission, whichever occurs sooner.
