ORDER CLOSING DOCKET

In response to a *Notice of Filing* issued by the Hearing Officer, Piedmont Natural Gas Company, Inc. filed a letter on September 9, 2021, stating that on July 15, 2021, it had provided confidential written responses to the questions of the Consumer Advocate Unit in the Financial Division of the Office of the Tennessee Attorney General ("Consumer Advocate"). Piedmont stated it was not aware of any other issues and requested that the docket be closed. On November 3, 2021, the Consumer Advocate filed a letter setting forth concerns regarding Piedmont's incentive plan mechanism and Piedmont's actions during the February energy crisis that prompted the questions to Piedmont. In addition, the Consumer Advocate recommended the Commission expand the review of Piedmont's Purchased Gas Adjustment ("PGA") filing and the incentive mechanism calculations. The Hearing Officer finds that Piedmont has responded to the Consumer Advocate's questions, and there are no other issues for consideration in this docket. Therefore, this docket should be CLOSED. IT IS SO ORDERED.
