This law firm serves as counsel for the Town of Collierville ("Town"). The Town is in receipt of a recent letter (see attached) from the Tennessee Public Utility Commission ("Commission") regarding an application filed by Telepak for a State-issued Certificate of Franchise Authority. This letter shall serve as the Town's response.

The Town currently has a franchise agreement with Comcast, which requires it to provide the Town with public, educational, and governmental ("PEG") channels and support payments. (This agreement was originally entered into between the Town and Time Warner Communications in 1996, and was assumed by Comcast in 2006.) In addition, AT&T operates in the Town pursuant to a State-issued Certificate of Franchise Authority.

To answer the specific questions contained in the Commission's recent letter:

- 1. Comcast, the "incumbent" cable service provider with the most subscribers in the Town, has activated two (2) PEG channels at this time.
- 2. Three (3) PEG channels are authorized to be activated under the Comcast franchise.
- 3. Comcast pays up to \$.35 per subscriber per month for capital support for PEG access equipment and facilities.

Dear Mayor Joyner:

On August 6, 2021, Telepak Networks, Inc ("Telepak") filed with the Tennessee Public Utility Commission ("Commission" or "Department") an application for a State-Issued Certificate of Franchise Authority to provide cable and/or broadband service in an area that includes your city. By this time, you should have already received notice from Telepak of its intention to serve your area. You may access this and other related filings on the TPUC's website at http://www.tn.gov/tra/dockets/2100088.htm. The Department is required to send this notice so that you may act to preserve your Public, Educational and Governmental ("PEG") channels and PEG access support payments under Tenn. Code Ann. § 7-59-309.1

If an incumbent cable TV provider currently serves your municipality,² and that provider's franchise requires that it provide PEG channels or access payments, then you may be able to receive the same number of PEG channels and equivalent support payments from Telepak. But, in order to claim these benefits, you must provide the TPUC with information about the PEG channels negotiated under your incumbent provider's franchise within ten (10) days from the date you received notice from Telepak that it intended to provide cable or video service to your municipality, specifically:

(1) The number of PEG channels that have been activated by the incumbent;

(2) The number of PEG channels that are authorized to be activated under the incumbent franchise; and,
(3) The amount of any fee or other payment for PEG access support required under the incumbent franchise.³
