AMENDED CERTIFICATE OF FRANCHISE AUTHORITY

On June 21, 2022, pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 7-59-301, *et seq.*, also known as the Competitive Cable and Video Services Act ("CCVSA"), Telepak Networks, Inc. ("Telepak") filed with the Tennessee Public Utility Commission ("Commission") an application to Amend its State Issued *Certificate of Franchise Authority*. In its Amendment, Telepak adds to its service areas the Cities of Bartlette, Arlington, Millington, Lakeland, Somerville, Piperton, Gallaway, Oakland, La Grange, Braden, Rossville, Williston, and Moscow, as well as the unincorporated areas of Shelby and Fayette Counties. Upon such filing the Tennessee Public Utility Commission hereby issues this Amendment to supplement Telepak's original *Certificate of Franchise Authority* issued September 3, 2021.
