



**3. Compliance with Applicable Laws (Tenn. Code Ann. § 7-59-305(c)(1)).**

Telepak agrees to comply with all applicable federal and state laws and regulations and will timely file with the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") all forms required by the FCC in advance of offering video services or cable services.

**4. Description of Municipalities and/or Unincorporated Areas Within Counties to be Served (Tenn. Code Ann. § 7-59-305(c)(2)).**

Telepak's original application for a state franchise covered a portion of Collierville, Tennessee. Telepak's first amended application added all of Fayette and all of Shelby County outside the city of Memphis. The first amended application should have listed all of the municipalities (other than Memphis) in Shelby and Fayette counties. Due to an oversight by Telepak's counsel in Tennessee, the municipality of Germantown, which is located in Shelby County, was not included among the municipalities listed in the first amended application. Similarly, the first amended application did not expressly mention the inclusion of that portion of Collierville that lies outside the original service area. Therefore, this second amended application requests expansion of Telepak's service area to include all of Germantown and Collierville. Exhibit A shows a map of the enlarged service area.

**5. Provision of cable service to service areas (Tenn. Code Ann. § 7-59-305(c)(3)).**

Telepak intends to begin to offer video or cable services and/or provide new broadband Internet service in portions of its expanded service area within twenty-four (24) months of the date of the issuance of an amended franchise as requested herein.

**6. Indemnification (Tenn. Code Ann. § 7-59-305(c)(4)).**

Telepak agrees to the indemnification provisions set forth in T.C.A. § 7-59-318, including Section (b) of the statute, which states, “Notwithstanding subsection (a), a holder of a state-issued certificate of franchise authority shall not be required to indemnify or hold harmless any indemnitee whose negligence or willful misconduct [such as the failure to comply with T.C.A. § 65-31-101 et seq. the ‘Underground Utility Damage Prevention Act’] caused the claims.”

**8. Financial, Managerial and Technical Qualifications to Provide Cable or Video Service and/or Broadband Internet Service (Tenn. Code Ann. §§ 7-59-305(c)(6) and(d)(2)).**

Telepak was granted a statewide franchise in 2021 (Order issued September 3, 2021) and relies upon the Commission's findings in that Order to demonstrate that Telepak has the financial, managerial and technical qualifications to provide the services described in paragraph 5.

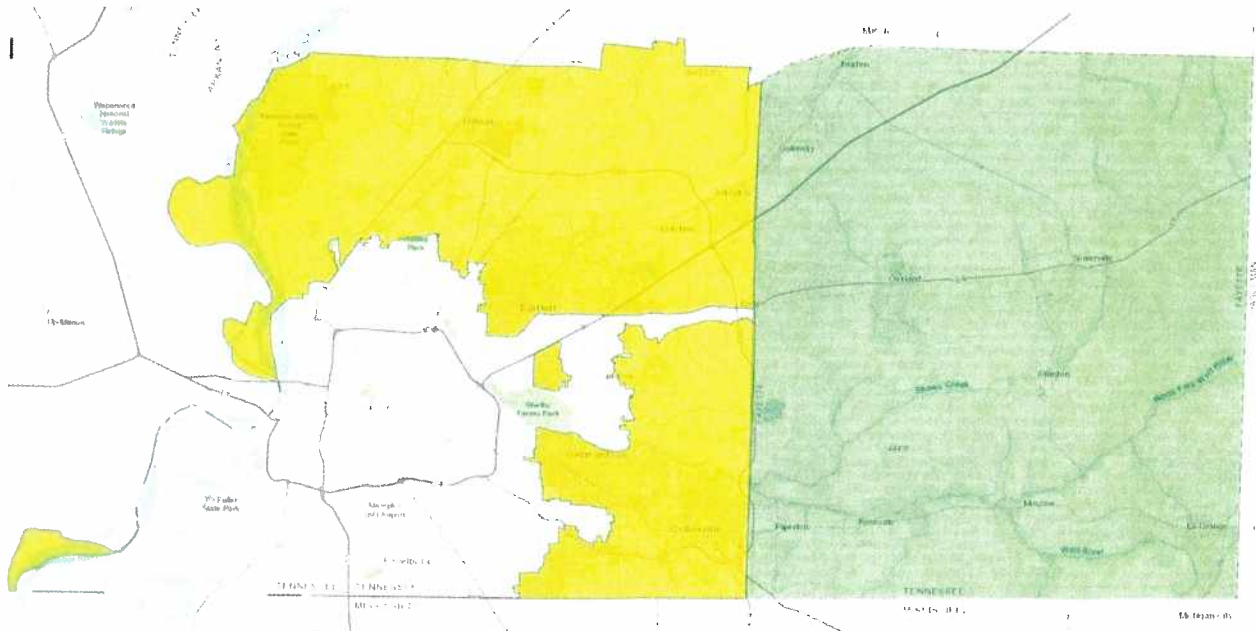
