ERRATA TO FIRST AMENDED CERTIFICATE OF FRANCHISE AUTHORITY

On June 21, 2022, pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 7-59-301, *et seq.*, also known as the Competitive Cable and Video Services Act (“CCVSA”), Telepak Networks, Inc. (“Telepak”) filed with the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“Commission”), the Affidavit of Alan Jones, Chief Network Officer, seeking to amend its state-issued *Certificate of Franchise Authority*. As amended, the Telepak service area is expanded to include the Cities of Bartlett, Arlington, Millington, Lakeland, Somerville, Piperton, Gallaway, Oakland, La Grange, Braden, Rossville, Williston, and Moscow, as well as the unincorporated areas of Shelby and Fayette Counties. Upon this filing, the Tennessee Public Utility Commission hereby issues this amendment to supplement Telepak’s original *Certificate of Franchise Authority* issued September 3, 2021.
