Re: Petition of Kingsport Power Company d/b/a AEP Appalachian Power General Rate Case, Docket No. 21-00107

To assist the Commission in its evaluation of this matter, please respond to the following requests for information:

- 1. Refer to Schedule 2, Line 2 of Attachment A to the Stipulation and Settlement Agreement. Please provide a breakdown of the individual Rate Base additions that comprise the settled amount of \$9,660,083. For Prepayments, show the breakdown of each item comprising the total Prepayment amount.
- 2. Please state whether Kingsport will be authorized under the Stipulation and Settlement to book a regulatory asset for deferred pension and/or OPEB costs for the Attrition Period. If so, please provide the amount of each such asset, provide a workpaper showing how the balance of each asset was computed, and state the associated period for amortizing each asset to expense.
- 3. In reference to Paragraph 16 of the Stipulation and Settlement Agreement, please state whether Kingsport will be required to seek and obtain Commission approval for the deferral and recovery of any rate case expense or COVID-19 cost above the initial

amounts stated in Paragraph 16.

- 4. In reference to Paragraph 16 of the Stipulation and Settlement Agreement, please state whether Outdoor Lighting Service and Street Lighting Service customers will be charged any amount under the rate design of the Administrative Cost Rider. If so, please provide the rider rates and associated billing determinants for these customer classes.
- 5. Please file a revised tariff consistent with the Settlement and include the sequential numbering scheme as required by Commission Rule 1220-04-01-.02 (i.e., please do not use original pages except for new material). Also please indicate in the margins whether the rate is an increase ("I'), text change ("T"), material change ("C"), or new ("N"). If text is moved from one page to another, state at the bottom of the page or in a footnote which former page the text and/or rates previously appeared.

Since a hearing is scheduled in this matter on July 11, 2022, a response is requested at your earliest possible convenience.
