**ORDER GRANTING *CONSUMER ADVOCATE’S MOTION TO FILE REBUTTAL
TESTIMONY***

This matter is before the Hearing Officer upon the *Consumer Advocate’s Motion in Limine to File Rebuttal Testimony* (“*Motion for Rebuttal*”) filed by the Consumer Advocate Unit in the Financial Division of the Office of the Tennessee Attorney General (“Consumer Advocate”) on June 7, 2022. In the *Motion for Rebuttal*, the Consumer Advocate requests permission to file “written testimony, rebutting, and responding to East Tennessee Energy Consumers’ (‘ETEC’) witness, Stephen Baron, regarding ‘certain rate design and other proposals and assertions set forth’ in his direct testimony.”¹
