
**NOTICE OF INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT AND AMENDMENT DEEMED
APPROVED**

This Paging Interconnection Agreement and Amendment (the “Agreement and Amendment”) negotiated between United Telephone Southeast, LLC d/b/a CenturyLink and USA Mobility Wireless, Inc. n/k/a Spok, Inc. were filed with the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (the “Commission”) on October 21, 2021.¹ The Agreement and Amendment were negotiated pursuant to 47 U.S.C. §§ 251 and 252. The Agreement and Amendment have been reviewed, and no portion discriminates against a telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the Agreement and Amendment.

A Notice was filed by the Commission on November 1, 2021 advising that the Agreement and Amendment would be deemed approved by the Commission within ten days of the filing of the Notice unless an objection to the Agreement and Amendment was filed with the Commission. No objection to the Agreement and Amendment has been received by the Commission.

Pursuant to the Notice and absent any objection having been filed with the Commission, the Agreement and Amendment are approved effective as of November 11, 2021.
