# DART KENDALL

- 1 Q. Please state your name, position and business address.
- A. My name is Dart Kendall. I am the President of Aqua Green Utility, Inc. My business
   address is 3350 Galts Road, Acworth, GA 30102.
- 4 Q. What is the purpose of your testimony in this proceeding?
- As the President of Aqua Green Utility, Inc., I am providing a general overview of Aqua
  Green Utility's operations and a summary of the rate relief that the Company is requesting
  in coordination with Commission staff. Michelle Mairs and Joe Shirley of the Commission
  staff will provide testimony on the ratemaking methodologies and calculations used to
  forecast the Company's cost of service and rate design for the attrition period in this case.
- 10 Q. Mr. Kendall, could you please briefly describe the Company's utility operations?
- A. Yes. Aqua Green Utility is a public utility as defined in Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-101 and 11 is engaged in providing environmentally friendly and affordable wastewater services to 12 fifteen residential customers and two commercial customers located in the counties of 13 14 Jefferson, Greene, and McNairy. The two commercial customers are Loves Truck Stops. The treatment systems are typically a fixed film type system with dispersal of treated 15 effluent water to a drip field. Agua Green Utility's wastewater treatment service includes 16 17 maintenance of the sewer treatment tanks, pressure lines and drip field. All systems are approved by the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation and all operation 18 19 and maintenance are done in a manner as to meet all requirements of the state operating 20 permits.
- 21 Q. When did Aqua Green Utility begin operating in Tennessee?
- A. The Commission granted Aqua Green Utility's first Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CCN) by an order entered on July 31, 2009 in Docket No. 09-00045. Since that

time Aqua Green Utility has obtained eight total CCNs to serve six residential subdivisions
 and two Loves Truck Stops.

## 3 Q. Has Aqua Green Utility ever increased service rates?

A.

A. No. Aqua Green Utility has never filed a rate case petition since it began operations in

Tennessee over twelve years ago in 2009. The currently tariffed rates and charges were

approved by the Commission as part of its granting Aqua Green Utility's first CCN.

# 7 Q. Mr. Kendall, why is Aqua Green Utility requesting rate relief at this time?

Due to increases in the expenses of operating Aqua Green Utility's wastewater systems over the last several years that are largely beyond the Company's control, the Company has experienced significant revenue shortfalls in recent years and cannot continue operating and providing wastewater services without experiencing financial losses. The Company has seen cost increases across the board, not only in our operating expenses for items such as electricity to run the wastewater plant, but Aqua Green Utility's property tax assessments and rates have increased substantially as well. Additionally, the Company has seen a need for increases in sludge pumping, and there has been increased pump damage for commercial customers caused by trash and clothing in the waste stream. Under the current rates and charges, the Company's existing level of revenues is simply not sufficient to allow the Company a fair opportunity to recover its reasonable operating costs and to provide a fair net operating income. It has become apparent that Aqua Green Utility will continue to experience unsustainable financial losses going forward without rate relief.

# Q. Are there any particular items the Company is requesting reimbursement for in this docket?

Yes. As part of this docket, Aqua Green Utility is also requesting the Commission to approve a disbursement of \$9,163 from its escrow account. Due to the Company's poor financial condition and lack of sufficient cash flow, testing invoices in the amount of \$4,800 were held and not booked to or paid by Aqua Green Utility. These invoices relate to the Company's required environmental testing and reporting to the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation during the test period. Additionally, costs totaling \$2,211 related to repair work completed at two customer locations that was necessary to restore and maintain wastewater service have not been charged to or paid by the Company. Finally, the necessary replacement of a grinder pump costing \$2,152 was completed for which no cost recovery or reimbursement has been made. These items, totaling \$9,163, were not paid from Aqua Green Utility's operating account due to lack of available funds to pay them. The Company is therefore requesting that the cost of these items be recovered through a one-time disbursement from the Company's escrow account. If the requested rate relief is granted in this docket, the Company's revenues and cash flows should be sufficient to pay for the costs of testing services and certain routine maintenance and repairs from the utility operating account in the attrition period. I also understand that any future disbursements from the Company's escrow account must first be preapproved by the Commission in accordance with its financial security rules for wastewater utilities.

# Q. What rate relief is the Aqua Green Utility requesting?

As will be addressed by the Commission staff, current rates and charges are insufficient to cover Aqua Green Utility's operating costs and provide for a reasonable net operating income. The Company has worked with Commission staff and provided staff with all requested financial and operational information. Without rate relief, the Commission staff

projects that Aqua Green Utility will have a revenue deficiency of approximately \$15,730 for the attrition year ending December 31, 2022, under the operating margin method. In order to have a fair opportunity to cover its reasonable operating expenses and taxes and earn a fair net operating income, Aqua Green Utility is requesting that it be allowed to increase rates and charges to eliminate the forecasted revenue deficiency. To that end, the Company supports and recommends the rates and rate design proposed by the staff and requests that the proposed rates become effective January 1, 2022.

# 8 Q. Have customer's been notified of the proposed rate increase?

- 9 A. Yes. On November 3, 2021, Aqua Green Utility mailed the attached customer Notice to 10 each of the Company's customers by first-class U.S. Mail.
- 11 Q. Does this conclude your testimony?
- 12 A. Yes it does.

#### Dear Valued Customer:

On November 5, 2021, Aqua Green Utility, Inc., will file a Joint Petition with Staff of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission to increase rates and charges for wastewater services. Aqua Green Utility has been providing wastewater services in Tennessee since 2009 and has never increased its service rates and charges since that time. Aqua Green Utility has made efforts to control the costs of providing services over that time, but the proposed increases are necessary to cover continuing revenue shortfalls due to increases in operating expenses and taxes over the last twelve years.

In sum, Aqua Green Utility is requesting the following rate changes for its monthly wastewater service and escrow charges and for its annual sewer access fee:

The rates proposed above exclude currently authorized riders, surcharges and taxes.

The Joint Petition requests that a rate hearing be conducted in this matter before a panel of Commissioners on December 6, 2021, and that the proposed rates and charges become effective January 1, 2022. The rate hearing is open to the public and will be held at 9:00 a.m. central time on December 6, 2021, in the Hearing Room on the Ground Floor of the Andrew Jackson State Office Building, 500 Deaderick Street, Nashville, Tennessee 37243. Additional public notice regarding the rate hearing will be posted on the Commission's website at least ten calendar days prior to the hearing.
