NOTICE OF ACCEPTANCE OF PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION **WITH FURTHER PROCEEDINGS YET TO BE DETERMINED**

IN RE: *Chattanooga Gas Company Petition for Approval of Tariff Amendments to Its T-1, T-2, and T-3 Tariffs*

DATE: March 7, 2023

On February 16, 2023, the Chattanooga Regional Manufacturers Association (CRMA) filed a *Petition to Reconsider* asking for further review of certain issues decided by the Commission panel to this docket, which are reflected in the *Order Approving Petition for Approval of Amendments to Its T1, T-2, and T-3 Tariffs, as Amended* (February 1, 2023). With its *Petition to Reconsider*, the CRMA also filed a *Motion to Take Administrative Notice of a Public Document in the Commission Files (Motion)* asking the Commission to take administrative notice of a December 22, 2023, email from the Consumer Advocate Unit in the Financial Division of the Office of the Tennessee Attorney General (Consumer Advocate) to Exeter Associates.

On February 23, 2023, Chattanooga Gas Company (CGC) filed its *Response in Opposition to Chattanooga Regional Manufacturers Association's Motion to Take Administrative Leave and Petition to Reconsider*. CGC opposes the requests of the CRMA in totality.

Please take notice that the Commission accepts the *Petition to Reconsider* and companion-filed *Motion* only to prevent the request for reconsideration from being deemed denied by operation of law. The Commission will consider the petition and motion on a later date. Separate notice will be issued concerning what, if any, further proceedings are needed.
