NOTICE OF AMENDMENT TO INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT DEEMED APPROVED

This Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement (the "Amendment") negotiated between CenturyTel of Adamsville, Inc. d/b/a CenturyLink Adamsville; CenturyTel of Claiborne, Inc. d/b/a CenturyLink Claiborne; CenturyTel of Ooltewah-Collegedale, Inc. d/b/a CenturyLink Ooltewah-Collegedale and DISH Wireless, LLC was filed with the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (the "Commission") on March 1, 2022.
