Aqua Green Utility Inc. desires to remove the Thunder Mountain Subdivision from our Certificate of Convenience and Necessity. The Developer has not fulfilled his side of the contract and the contract is now breached, so our contract is no longer valid. The property was to be deeded to the utility before any sewage could be accepted to the plant. After a notice to cure and almost two years of repeatedly asking, the land was not deeded. As you know, this is a requirement of our TPUC approval. Only 1 cabin is built and could be connected to a septic system if they cannot find a different operator of the system. No other cabins are started. We are also requesting that TDEC cancel the SOP for this project.
