SECOND REPORT ON THE STATUS OF COMPLIANCE

This report is to provide an update to the Tennessee Public Utility Commission ("TPUC" or "Commission") on the compliance status of the Laurel Creek Subdivision, pursuant to the Order Approving Petition to Amend Certificate of Convenience and Necessity and Waive Commission Rule ("Order"). The Order requires Limestone Water Utility Operating Company, LLC ("Limestone") to file a report on the status of providing wastewater service to the Laurel Creek Subdivision, as well as the status of its compliance with each of the filing requirements. The requirements include that Limestone file the following: (1) the deed and/or easements for all the land and ownership right to the wastewater system within 15 days of being issued and before the first customer is connected to the wastewater system, (2) a final copy of the State Operating Permit issued by the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation within 15 days of issuance, (3) as-built plans with signed certifications by Limestone indicating the wastewater system has

been inspected and is approved to begin operation, and (4) a copy of the signed plat, once the area

of development is approved by the City and/or County government, within 15 days of being issued

and before the first customer is connected to the wastewater system.³

On July 24, 2024, Limestone filed with the Commission the final State Operating Permit

issued by the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation, thereby meeting that

requirement. Further, Limestone reports that construction at the site is still ongoing, and therefore

none of the remaining documents are available at this time. Limestone commits to file the required

documents once available and within the timeframes specified in the Order.
