I, Lexanne Horton, in accordance with the requirements of the Tennessee Competitive Cable and Video Services Act, Tenn. Code Ann. § 7-59-305 et seq. (the "Act"), state as follows:

I am an employee of E. Ritter Communications Holdings, LLC, d/b/a Ritter Communications, where my title is Chief Financial Officer. As such, I am authorized to make this affidavit on behalf of Applicant E. Ritter Communications Holdings, LLC, d/b/a Ritter Communications.

1. Name of Applicant

The name of the Applicant is E. Ritter Communications Holdings, LLC, d/b/a Ritter Communications (hereinafter referred to as "Applicant" or "Ritter"). Applicant received a State-Issued Certificate of Franchise Authority to serve the areas specified therein on August 26, 2022. The purpose of this Application is to Amend Its State-Issued Certificate of Franchise Authority ("First Amendment") to add new Service Areas as provided herein.

2. Application Fee for Service Area Population of over 50,000, up to and including 100,000 (Section 305(b)(2) of the Act)

An application fee of \$500 is submitted with this First Amendment consistent with Section 305(b)(2) of the Act and based on the population of service area(s) as reflected in the most recent decennial census applied for in this First Amendment. Such service areas are described in Exhibit A.

3. Compliance with Applicable Laws (Section 305(c)(1) of the Act)

Applicant agrees to comply with all applicable federal and state laws and regulations to the extent that such state laws and regulations are not in conflict with or superseded by the provisions of this part or other applicable law and will timely file with the FCC all forms required by the FCC in advance of offering video services or cable services as set forth in this First Amendment. Applicant will comply with all applicable FCC requirements involving the distribution and notification of emergency messages over the emergency alert system consistent with the enforcement of the rules, and any waivers to the rules, as determined by the FCC.

4. Description of Municipalities and Unincorporated Areas to be Added to the Area Served by Applicant Pursuant to its Existing Franchise Issued on August 26, 2022 (Section 305(c)(2) of the Act)

This First Amendment seeks to add service for the city of Bartlett, TN which is in Shelby County. Exhibit A to this First Amendment provides a detailed map of the municipalities within the county to be served, in whole or in part, by the Applicant pursuant to this First Amendment. Exhibit A is incorporated by reference into this Affidavit.

5. Intent to Begin to Offer Cable or Broadband Internet Service (Section 305(c)(3) of the Act)

Applicant already provides video and cable services in areas that are contiguous and in close proximity with the municipalities identified in <u>Exhibit A</u> and intends to begin to offer video and cable service for purchase in the areas identified in <u>Exhibit A</u> within twenty-four (24) months of the date of issuance of an Amended State-Issued Certificate of Franchise Authority.

6. Indemnification (Section 305(c)(4) of the Act)

Applicant agrees to indemnify and hold harmless, in accordance with Section 318 of the Act, the state, municipality, county and any employee or representative of the state, municipality or county, as well as any political subdivision of the state and any employee or representative of the political subdivision, individually and collectively, referred to in Section 318 of the Act as the "indemnitee."

Applicant has the managerial, financial and technical qualifications to provide cable or video service as required by Tenn. Code Ann. § 7-59-305(c)(6) and (d)(2). Applicant has evaluated its deployment plans and reasonably concludes that its plans will result in deployment of cable or video service to all service areas listed on Exhibit A within the time periods set forth in and in compliance with Tenn. Code Ann. § 7-59-311. Applicant agrees to comply with the non-discrimination and service deployment requirements of § 7-59-311.

Applicant has the managerial, financial and technical qualifications to fulfill this plan of deployment. Applicant was granted a State-Issued Certificate of Franchise Authority in 2022, and has been providing cable and video services pursuant to that Certificate, and therefore the Commission has determined that Applicant has the managerial, financial, and technical qualifications to provide cable and video services. Based on Applicant's experience and success providing cable and video services, Applicant has the managerial, financial, and technical qualifications to provide similar cable and video services.

Applicant has been providing video services to customers in West Tennessee for over 45 years. In addition, Applicant's subsidiary, Millington CATV, Inc., has provided cable service to unincorporated areas of Shelby County, Tennessee area pursuant to a state-issued certificate of franchise authority issued by this Commission's predecessor agency, the Tennessee Regulatory Authority, in 2012, and it provided cable service pursuant to local franchises for over thirty three (33) years prior to that certificate. Ritter Communications provides common corporate

administration and management for all operational service areas which will also include the new service areas of this amendment.

9. Customer Service Complaint Handling Process (Section 305(c)(7) of the Act)

Should a customer believe that his/her request was not properly handled, he/she may contact the Tennessee Regulatory Authority.

1.0 PLAN

- 1.1 This Small and Minority-Owned Telecommunications Business Participation Plan ("Plan") is submitted by E. Ritter Communications, LLC, dba Ritter Communications ("Company"), as required by TCA § 65-5-112.

 - (c) Ensures inclusion of Small and Minority-Owned Businesses in those solicitations for products or services which they are capable of providing.
 - (d) Maintains Small and Minority-Owned Business related correspondence and record keeping.
 - (e) Coordinates activities during the conduct of any compliance review by the Tennessee state agencies.
