Thank you for submitting correspondence and documents for consideration in Docket No. 22-00099 concerning the Isha Foundation, Inc. Petition. The time period for reconsideration or appeal of the order issued in this docket has expired. Therefore, these documents cannot form the basis for a reconsideration or appeal of the Commission's order in this docket.

In addition, upon review, the issues raised in your documents relate to matters that were examined by Commission Staff prior to the issuance of an order. Upon consideration, it was determined that, in the context of the purpose of the project, the wastewater system does not qualify as a public utility, such that the agency has jurisdiction to regulate it.

I will note that while the Commission will not regulate the Isha Foundation's wastewater facility as a public utility, the operation of the facility is subject to the safety and environmental regulations of the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation.
