## ORDER ON MARCH 9<sup>th</sup> STATUS CONFERENCE AND SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This matter came before the Hearing Officer of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission ("Commission" or "TPUC") during the telephone Status Conference held on March 9, 2023, to discuss discovery disputes. During the Status Conference, the parties discussed the disputed discovery requests set forth in the *Motion to Compel* filed by Mr. McCabe on March 2, 2023. TWSI suggested that a second round of discovery might be necessary to resolve Mr. McCabe's additional questions.

At the end of the Status Conference, Mr. McCabe had not decided whether a second round of discovery was needed and noted that his Rebuttal Testimony was due on March 10<sup>th</sup>. The Hearing Officer determined the *Order Establishing Procedural Schedule* ("*Procedural Schedule*") issued on December 15, 2022, should be suspended to allow time for discovery disputes to be resolved and for any additional discovery. Therefore, the Hearing Officer suspends the *Procedural Schedule* until discovery disputes are resolved, discovery can be completed, and a new procedural schedule issued.
