ORDER ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This matter is before the Hearing Officer of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“Commission” or “TPUC”) to establish a procedural schedule for the orderly administration of these proceedings. Tennessee Water Services, Inc. (“TWS”), Corix Infrastructure (US) Inc. (“Corix”), and the Consumer Advocate Unit of the Office of the Attorney General (“Consumer Advocate”), the parties in this matter, filed the *Parties’ Joint Proposed Amended Procedural Schedule* (“*Proposed Procedural Schedule*”) on January 27, 2023. The goal and design of any procedural schedule is to efficiently move the proceedings forward to a hearing and final conclusion on the merits. Nevertheless, a procedural schedule’s effectiveness directly depends on cooperation by the parties in meeting the individual benchmark dates. - Rebuttal Testimony is limited only to issues raised in the Consumer Advocate's Direct Testimony and should include the page and line number of the Consumer Advocate's testimony that is being rebutted.
