**NOTICE OF AMENDMENT TO INTERCONNECTION  
AGREEMENT DEEMED APPROVED**

On November 14, 2022, an Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement (the “Amendment”) negotiated between Bellsouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T Tennessee and DeltaCom, Inc. was filed with the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (the “Commission”).<sup>1</sup> The Amendment was negotiated pursuant to 47 U.S.C. §§ 251 and 252. Upon review, it has been determined that no portion of the Amendment discriminates against a telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the agreement.

The Commission issued a Notice on December 29, 2022 that the Amendment would be deemed approved by the Commission within ten days of the filing date of the Notice unless an objection to the Amendment was filed with the Commission. To-date no objection to the Amendment has been filed with the Commission. Therefore, in accordance with the Notice and absent any objection having been filed with the Commission, the Amendment is approved effective as of January 8, 2023.
