

On November 18, 2022, the North American Plan Administrator (“NANPA”), in its role as the neutral third-party numbering plan area (“NPA”) (a/k/a, “area code”) relief planner for Tennessee and on behalf of the Tennessee telecommunications industry (“Industry”), filed with the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) its *Petition of the North American Numbering Plan Administrator on Behalf of the Tennessee Telecommunications Industry for Relief of the 423 Numbering Plan Area* (“Petition”).

In its *Petition*, NANPA states that the 423-area code, covering two non-contiguous areas in eastern Tennessee, is projected to exhaust its central office codes during the third quarter of 2025 and is in need of relief. As such, it requests Commission approval of the Industry’s plan to implement an all-services distributed overlay based on a 13-month schedule to be completed at least 6-months prior to the projected exhaust date.

Any interested parties who wish to file written comments on the NANPA Petition and Industry’s recommended plan for area code relief may do so in the above-referenced docket file. The docket will remain open for comments until **2:00 p.m. on April 21, 2023**.
