An electronic hearing using the WebEx videoconferencing platform will be held in the above-captioned matter at **10:00 a.m. (CDT) on Thursday, October 31, 2024**. The purpose of the hearing is to consider an emergency request by the North American Numbering Plan Administrator ("NANPA") to extend for an additional six (6) months the implementation of the permissive dialing period for the 423/792 numbering plan area due to the severe impacts caused by Hurricane Helene in East Tennessee.

Vice Chairman John Hie, Commissioner Robin L. Morrison, Commissioner Clay R. Good, Commissioner Kenneth C. Hill, and Commissioner David Crowell, the panel assigned to this docket, will conduct the hearing in accordance with the Tennessee Uniform Administrative Procedures Act, Tenn.
