**Re: *Petition of Kingsport Power Company d/b/a AEP Appalachian Power for October 2021 through December 2022 Annual Recovery under the Targeted Reliability Plan and Major Storm Rider ("TRP&MS"), Alternative Rate Mechanism Approved in Docket No. 17-00032***

Dear Mr. Harvey:

To assist the Commission in its continuing evaluation of this matter, please respond to the following request for information:

1. Refer to Excel file KgPCo Exhibit No. 1 (MLD).xlsx, cell AH16. Please provide an explanation for why the beginning 9/30/21 unrecovered rider balance is shown as (\$6,011,424) and not (\$5,996,015). The Commission-approved balance at 9/30/21 in the Company's most recent TRP & MS Rider filing, docket 21-00142, is (\$5,575,629). This Commission-approved amount reflects the Company's (\$6,011,424) balance at 9/30/21 in that most recent docket, reduced by (a) \$420,386 related to Street Lighting customers and (b) \$15,410 for the net correction of errors as addressed in the Company's responses to Consumer Advocate's data requests 3-8 and 4-5. The notes shown in KgPCo Exhibit No. 1 (MLD) in the current Company filing indicate the \$420,386 Street Lighting adjustment was made in September and December 2022. However, the net \$15,410 reduction for the correction of errors does not appear to be reflected in the Company's calculations.
