NOTICE OF COLLOCATION AMENDMENT TO TRAFFIC EXCHANGE
AGREEMENT DEEMED APPROVED

On May 8, 2023, a Collocation Amendment to the Traffic Exchange Agreement (the “Amendment”) negotiated between Brightspeed of Eastern Tennessee, LLC f/k/a CenturyTel of Claiborne, Inc., Brightspeed of Southern Tennessee, LLC f/k/a CenturyTel of Ooltewah-Collegedale, Inc. and Charter Fiberlink-Tennessee, LLC was filed with the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (the “Commission”).¹ The Amendment was negotiated pursuant to 47 U.S.C. §§ 251 and 252. Upon review, it has been determined that no portion of the Amendment discriminates against a telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the agreement.

The Commission issued a Notice on May 10, 2023 that the Amendment would be deemed approved within ten days of the filing date of the Notice unless an objection to the Amendment was filed with the Commission. To-date no objection to the Amendment has been filed with the Commission. Therefore, in accordance with the Notice and absent any objection having been filed with the Commission, the Amendment is approved effective May 20, 2023.
