ORDER ON MOTION FOR CUSTOMIZED CASE MANAGEMENT

This matter came before the Court on January 11, 2024, on Plaintiff Superior Wastewater Systems, LLC's Motion for Customized Case Management, to which Defendant Tennessee Wastewater Systems, Inc., timely filed a Response in Opposition. After consideration of the record and the arguments of counsel, the Court finds that the Motion should be **GRANTED**. Accordingly, the Court **ORDERS** as follows:

1. Counsel for the parties shall meet and confer regarding the contents of a proposed case management order by no later than **February 9, 2024**. That proposed case management order shall comply with the requirements of Section 9.04 of the Local Rules and shall specifically include (a) a summary of the claims and defenses, (b) proposed deadlines for completing discovery, engaging in a good faith mediation, and submitting dispositive motions, and (c) an estimated trial date.

2. The parties shall jointly submit their proposed case management order by no later than **February 16, 2024**.


