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

ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO LIFT STAY

This matter is before the Administrative Judge upon the *Unopposed Motion to Lift Stay on Proceedings* (“*Motion*”) filed by Superior Wastewater Systems, LLC (“SWS”) on August 21, 2024. In its *Motion*, SWS seeks to lift the stay on the proceedings in this docket because it is no longer needed. SWS states that on January 23, 2024, the Administrative Judge entered an *Order Granting Motion to Hold Docket in Abeyance* that held these proceedings in abeyance until the conclusion of the Williamson County Chancery Court case between Tennessee Wastewater Systems, Inc. (“TWSI”) and SWS. According to SWS, on July 30, 2024, Williamson County Chancery Court entered an order dismissing the case involving TWSI and SWS.¹ Therefore, SWS seeks to lift the stay and proceed with the proceedings before the Tennessee Public Utility Commission.² SWS states TWSI does not oppose this *Motion*.³

The Administrative Judge finds that Superior Wastewater Systems, LLC’s *Unopposed Motion to Lift Stay on Proceedings* is well taken and should be **GRANTED**.
