ORDER GRANTING REQUEST TO MOVE DOCKET TO THE JUNE COMMISSION CONFERENCE AGENDA

This matter is before the Administrative Judge of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission ("Commission" or "TPUC") for consideration of a joint request by Limestone Water Utility Operating Company, LLC, Sunset Cove Condominium HOA of Norris Lake, Inc., and Commercial Bank (together "Joint Petitioners"), and the Consumer Advocate Division of the Office of the Attorney General ("Consumer Advocate"), the parties in this matter, to remove this matter from the May 12, 2024 Commission Conference Agenda.

This matter was initially contemplated for the March 2024 Commission Agenda but was moved to the May agenda because issues arose in another Limestone docket, and the current docket potentially had similar issues. Therefore, it was decided that it would be best to have both dockets heard on the May Commission Agenda. On April 4, 2024, the Administrative Judge notified the parties via email that a Settlement Agreement in this matter would need to be filed by April 25th

since the matter was scheduled to be placed on the Commission Agenda for May. On May 10, 2024, the Administrative Judge received an email from the parties requesting that this docket be moved to the June 2024 Commission Conference to allow the parties time to finalize a Settlement Agreement. The Administrative Judge finds that the parties' request to remove this docket from the May 2024 Commission Conference Agenda and instead place it to the June 2024 Commission Conference Agenda is well taken and should be **GRANTED**.
