# CUMBERLAND BASIN WASTEWATER SYSTEMS, LLC'S SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSES TO CONSUMER ADVOCATE'S FIRST SET OF DISCOVERY REQUESTS

Cumberland Basin Wastewater Systems, LLC ("Cumberland Basin"), by and through counsel, hereby submits its Supplemental Responses to the First Set of Discovery Requests propounded by the Consumer Advocate Division of the Attorney General's Office ("Consumer Advocate"). Cumberland Basin incorporates by reference its General Objections into these Supplemental Responses.

## SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSES TO FIRST SET OF DISCOVERY REQUESTS

**1-10.** Does Cumberland Basin intend to transfer the balance of the Escrow account(s) at closing? If not, provide an explanation for the Company's rationale for retaining the balance of the Escrow account(s).

**RESPONSE**: Cumberland Basin will transfer the balance of the escrow account at closing.

1-11. Refer to the Company's 2022 Annual Report. Specifically, refer to page SU-2. Provide the

general ledger detail supporting the escrow balance shown. Additionally, provide a

narrative response describing why the assets recorded to the escrow account do not equal

the liabilities recorded to escrow.

**RESPONSE**: Please refer to the General Ledger in CONFIDENTIAL Attachment DR 1-5, filed

with Cumberland Basin's initial discovery responses. Specifically, please see accounts

132.1–Escrow Deposits and 235.1–Escrow Liabilities for the detail supporting the escrow

balances shown in the 2022 Annual Report. Escrow is funded from a portion of the

revenues collected for service. Per its approved tariff, Cumberland Basin collects

\$7.03/month from customers at The Bluffs at Cumberland Cove and \$14.94/month from

customers at Genesis Village Estates, which are deposited annually into the escrow account

for each system. When Cumberland Basin receives the Annual Report for the preceding

year each March, it makes a deposit to match the escrow liabilities. If you refer to

Cumberland Basin's 2021 Annual Report, page SU-2, the liabilities of \$5,568.73 were

deposited into the escrow account in March 2022 as shown in the 2022 Annual Report.

1-15. Confirm that the Security Deposits currently held by Cumberland Basin for customers will

be transferred as part of the sale. If not confirmed, provide an explanation for the

Company's rationale for not transferring the held Security Deposits.

**RESPONSE**: Confirmed.
