Superior Wastewater Systems Quarterly Status Update on Triune - Docket #23-00085 September 4, 2024

As required per the CCN amendment, Docket #23-00085, approved by TPUC on March 4, 2024, below is the current status of each of the requested documents related to the Triune Parcel.

Item	Required Document	Status as of September 4, 2024
1	The deed and/or easements for all the land and ownership rights to the wasterwater system within 15 days of being issued and before the first customer is connected to the wasterwater system as set forth in contracts submitted by Superior with the Commission.	Triune Development, LLC has purchased the acerage required for sewer plant and drip field. They should begin construction in 3 months. Once completed the system and land will be gifted to Superior Wastewater Systems, LLC.
2	A final copy of the State Operating Permit issued by the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation ("TDEC") within 15 days of issuance	Construction documents and permit is currently approved but pending from TDEC.
3	A copy of the as-built plans with signed certification by Superior indicating the wastewater system has been inspected and is approved to begin operation	Construction has not started
4	A copy of the signed plat, once the area of development is approved by the City and/or County government within 15 days of being issued and before the first customer is connected to the wastewater system	This will not occur until 2025
5	A copy of the performance bond from the developer or builder of the wastewater system made payable to Superior to ensure the construction of the wastewater system. The performance bond(s) should be for an amount equal to or greater than the cost of the system as provided in contracts between builder, developer and/or Utility	The county bond will not occur until 2025
6	Copies of all contracts between the Utility and all developers/builders of the system, including any affiliated companies	None exist at this time
