In the *Consumer Advocate’s Petition to Obtain Information from Tennessee American Water Company Pertaining to Differing Rates Charged To Its Customers Among Its Service Areas* (“*Petition*”) filed by the Consumer Advocate Division of the Office of the Tennessee Attorney General (“Consumer Advocate”) on January 24, 2024, the Consumer Advocate asked that the Commission grant its request to obtain certain information from Tennessee-American Water Company (“TAWC”). On February 16, 2024, TAWC filed a letter stating it had previously engaged in cooperative discussions with the Consumer Advocate on rate design and had provided some of the requested information. TAWC stated it was in the process of compiling the additional information and asked that the Commission not take any action on the Consumer Advocate’s *Petition* and give it until June 6, 2024, to provide the information requested. On April 19, 2024, TAWC provided the response to the Consumer Advocate’s request for information.

To date, there have not been any other filings or correspondence regarding this docket. Therefore, the parties are directed to file an update on the status of this docket by **June 28, 2024**, including whether there is a need for this docket to remain open.
