ORDER CLOSING DOCKET

In response to a *Notice of Filing* issued by the Administrative Judge, the Consumer Advocate Division of the Office of the Tennessee Attorney General (“Consumer Advocate”) filed a letter on June 25, 2024, stating Tennessee-American Water Company (“TAWC”) had provided the requested information and had also filed a rate case with the Commission. The Consumer Advocate stated it believed “the information would be brought to light in TPUC Docket No. 24-00032 [the rate case docket in which the Consumer Advocate is an Intervenor].”¹ The Consumer Advocate maintained the current docket was no longer needed and should be closed.

The Administrative Judge finds that there are no other issues for consideration in this docket. Therefore, this docket should be **CLOSED**.
