2		RECORD.
3	<i>A1</i> .	My name is John Powell, and my business address is PO Box 40, Arrington, TN
4		37014.
5		
6	<i>Q2.</i>	BY WHOM ARE YOU EMPLOYED AND IN WHAT CAPACITY?
7	<i>A2</i> .	I am the owner and president of Superior Wastewater Systems, LLC ("SWS") a
8		provider of wastewater utility service, regulated by this Commission.
9		
10	Q3.	WHAT ARE YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES FOR SWS?
11	<i>A3</i> .	I am responsible for the day-to-day operation, permitting, and long-term planning
12		Among other things, this includes supervision of the system; review and approval
13		of expenditures; reviewing and resolving customer issues; scoping and obtaining
14		proposals for maintenance work; establishment of contracts; contact with
15		regulatory personnel on existing and future permit requirements and issues;
16		preparation of portions of and review of tariff documents; investigation of
17		physical and operational conditions of the distribution systems; and evaluation of
18		proposals for plant upgrades and replacement.
19		
20	Q4.	WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF YOUR TESTIMONY IN THIS
21		PROCEEDING?

1	<b>A4.</b>	The purpose of my testimony is to present information to the Tennessee Public
2		Utility Commission ("TPUC" or "the Commission") to support SWS's Petition to
3		withdraw escrow funds as permitted by Tenn. Rules and Regs. 1220-4-1307(7).
4		
5	Q5.	MR. POWELL, PLEASE DESCRIBE THE NATURE OF THE REQUEST
6		TO WITHDRAW FUNDS FROM ESCROW.
7	A5.	On November 30, 2023, SWS experienced the complete loss of two pumps due to
8		a collapsed pipe that allowed gravel to enter the pumps and destroy their ability to
9		function. SWS has completely replaced the collapsed pipe as well as the two
10		pumps and now seeks to recover the related cost of \$5,274.18, inclusive of the
11		regulatory and legal costs necessary to file this Petition, from its escrow reserve
12		fund.
13		
14	Q6.	DO THE COMMISSION'S RULES ALLOW FOR RECOVERY OF
15		REPLACEMENT COSTS FROM ESCROW?
16	A6.	Yes. The Tenn. Rules and Regs. 1220-4-1307(7) anticipate and allow for such a
17		recovery of extraordinary expenditures from escrow funds and read as follows:
18		Reserve/escrow accounts established by a public wastewater utility shall be
19		limited to paying for or reimbursing the utility for extraordinary expenses
20		of the utility or for necessary capital projects, unless otherwise permitted
21		by the Commission. Extraordinary expenses are those resulting from events
22		which are infrequent and unusual in nature, and unrelated to the utilities'
23		routine service or business activities. The utility must first receive
24		authorization from the Commission via approved petition or, in emergency
25		situations, authorization in writing from the Chairman of the Commission
76		upon written request by a representative of the utility to use such funds. The
26		
26 27 28		Commission may require public wastewater utility employees having signature authority over such accounts to obtain a fidelity bond. The public

2 3		wastewater utility's tariff shall set forth the specific amount charged to customers to fund the reserve/escrow account.
4	Q7.	ARE THESE REPLACEMENT COSTS INFREQUENT AND UNUSUAL
5		AS DESCRIBED IN TENN. RULES AND REGS. 1220-4-1307(7)?
6	A7.	Yes.
7		
8	Q8.	DOES SWS HAVE ANY OTHER MEANS TO RECOVER THESE
9		REPLACEMENT COSTS?
10	A8.	No. These replacement costs, as well as the regulatory and legal costs associated
11		with filing this Petition, are not included in SWS's base rates. As a result, SWS
12		has no means to recover these replacements costs other than through a withdrawal
13		from our escrow reserve.
14		
15	Q9.	PLEASE DESCRIBE THE DIFFERENT COMPONENTS OF THE
16		REPLACEMENT COSTS.
17	A9.	A summary of the direct and indirect replacement components that total to
18		\$5,274.18 are shown below on Table 1. The details supporting these summarized
19		amounts are shown on Exhibit JP-1 to my testimony.


