

testimony of Mr. Novak. I concur in part with and reject in part the Consumer Advocate's recommendations. The recommendations of the Consumer Advocate, and the Company's position to each recommendation, are summarized in the following table:

The purpose of my testimony is twofold:

1. Present the Company's updated revenue requirement model reflecting its rebuttal position in Exhibit WDM-R-1; and
2. Concur in part with and reject in part the Consumer Advocate's modeling adjustments as listed in Table R-1.

Q. HAVE YOU UPDATED THE COMPANY'S REVENUE REQUIREMENT MODEL TO REFLECT THESE ADJUSTMENTS AND RECOMMENDATIONS?

A. Yes. The updated revenue requirement model is attached to this rebuttal testimony

1 as Exhibit WDM-R-1.

2 **III. REVENUE REQUIREMENT ADJUSTMENTS**

3 **Q. PLEASE DISCUSS THE ADJUSTMENTS MADE BY THE COMPANY IN**
4 **ITS REBUTTAL POSITION AS SHOWN ON EXHIBIT WDM-R-1.**

5 A. The Company's updated revenue requirement model is summarized in Table R-2,
6 below. The request in response to which the Company made each adjustment, as
7 well as the workpaper or tab on WDM-R-1 which reflects each adjustment, are as
8 follows:

- 9 • DR 1-28, Adjustment to Short Term Debt Rate from 17.36% to 17.51%;
10 • DR 1-30, Removal of unregulated long-term debt, increase long-term debt rate
11 from 3.92% to 3.95%.

12 The impact of these two cost of capital changes as recommended by CAD, and
13 agreed to by the Company and incorporated in this rebuttal model WDM-R-1,
14 results in an updated overall rate of return of 7.64%. This is consistent with the
15 proposal made at Page 9, Line 7 through Page 10, Line 9 of Mr. Novak's direct
16 testimony.

17 **Q. CAN YOU BREAK OUT THE DOLLAR IMPACTS OF EACH OF THOSE**
18 **ADJUSTMENTS?**

19 A. As calculated by the Company and incorporated into its rebuttal, the impact to these
20 Cost of Capital changes is an increase of \$166,477 to the Company's original
21 revenue requirement request, which is slightly different than the CAD's

1 recommendation of \$164,674.¹ This difference is likely due to rounding differences
2 and the Company's calculations may be found in WDM-R-1.

4 **Q. DOES THE COMPANY AGREE WITH THE CONSUMER ADVOCATE'S**
5 **ADJUSTMENTS AS INCORPORATED BY THE COMPANY IN ITS WDM-**
6 **R-1 REBUTTAL MODEL?**

7 A. Yes. The Company agrees with the CAD's adjustments to reflect an overall cost
8 of capital in this proceeding of 7.64% and as shown in the Company's
9 responses to CAD's Discovery Requests 1-28 and 1-30. The short-term debt rate
10 adjustment is reflected on WP 9-2 of WDM-R-1 and the long-term debt rate
11 adjustment is reflected on WP 9-3 of WDM-R-1.

12 **Q. DOES THE COMPANY AGREE WITH THE CONSUMER ADVOCATE'S**
13 **OTHER ADJUSTMENTS IN TESTIMONY OTHER THAN THOSE**
14 **SHOWN AND INCORPORATED ON TABLE R-2?**

15 A. No.

16 **Q. HAVING ADDRESSED THE AREAS WHERE THE COMPANY AGREES**
17 **WITH THE CONSUMER ADVOCATE, LET'S TURN TO THE AREAS**

1 **WHERE THE PARTIES DISAGREE. WOULD YOU PLEASE DISCUSS**
2 **THE ADJUSTMENT TO OTHER REVENUES BY THE CONSUMER**
3 **ADVOCATE?**

4 A. The Consumer Advocate proposed a pro forma adjustment to Other Revenues that
5 restores this item back to the same level approved in the Company’s last rate case
6 (“14-00146”). As part of the settlement agreement in the Company’s 2023 ARM
7 filing, the Company agreed to turn on late payment fees and miscellaneous service
8 charges (collectively “Other Revenues,” which had been shut off by Commission
9 order during the COVID-19 pandemic) going forward, and these rates began to be
10 collected again in July 2023. Since the Other Revenues only reflect 3 months
11 within the historic test period in this case, the CAD has proposed an adjustment to
12 “normalize” these revenues. This adjustment involves basically picking the
13 Company’s 14-00146 Other Revenues amounts, inclusive of the 14-00146 forfeited
14 discount factor calculation of 1.0971%. The total impact of this proposed
15 adjustment is to decrease the revenue deficiency by \$1,271,171.

16 **Q. DOES THE COMPANY AGREE WITH THIS ADJUSTMENT AS**
17 **DISCUSSED IN MR. NOVAK’S PRE-FILED TESTIMONY?**

18 A. No. Mr. Novak’s recommendation is against the Approved Methodologies.² In
19 effect, Mr. Novak’s recommendation to adopt an Other Revenues amount of
20 \$1,239,248 is an effort to pick-and-choose amounts to “normalize” rather than

1 following the true-up process that is part of the Approved Methodologies. Other
2 Revenues, in addition to revenue in general, will be factored into next year's ARM
3 filing and overall revenues will be trued-up, up or down, in accordance with the
4 Approved Methodologies.

5 **Q. IS MR. NOVAK'S RECOMMENDATION OF A FORFEITED DISCOUNT**
6 **FACTOR OF 1.0971% FROM 14-00146 AGAINST THE APPROVED**
7 **METHODOLOGIES AS WELL?**

8 A. Yes. Mr. Novak's recommendation of 1.0971% as the forfeited discount factor is
9 against the Approved Methodologies. Specifically, the 1.0971% utilizes margins
10 as the denominator in the calculation, whereas the Approved Methodology is to
11 utilize revenues. The Consumer Advocate has admitted in discovery that the
12 Company's use of revenues in its submissions in this case was consistent with the
13 Approved Methodologies.³ The issue of the proper denominator for the forfeited
14 discount factor was individually referenced in setting forth the Approved
15 Methodologies within Item 10 from the settlement agreement in Docket No. 18-
16 00112.⁴ Although the Approved Methodologies originally used margins as the
17 denominator, that changed several years ago at the Consumer Advocate's own
18 request. The Consumer Advocate initially noted and advocated for use of total
19 revenues as the denominator in both discovery and testimony in Docket No. 18-

1 00097. That position eventually led to the incorporation of revenue as the
2 denominator on the forfeited discount factor in the current Approved Methodology
3 in Docket No. 18-00112, which is controlling for this ARM filing.⁵ In addition,
4 Mr. Novak's recommendation of the 14-00146 amount goes directly against the
5 Approved Methodology for the calculation of the factor in general, as it does not
6 utilize either forfeited discount actuals nor does it utilize revenues as the
7 denominator. As mentioned above, to the extent the amounts do not reflect a full
8 year's amount of Other Revenues, the true-up for next year's ARM filing will
9 capture these adjustments per the Approved Methodologies.

10 **Q. WHAT IS THE FORFEITED DISCOUNT FACTOR PER THE APPROVED**
11 **METHODOLOGIES?**

12 A. The Company's forfeited discount factor, calculated per the Approved
13 Methodologies, is 0.0337% as shown on WP 8-2 in both its initial filing as well as
14 WDM-R-1.⁶

15 **Q. DOES THE COMPANY AGREE WITH MR. NOVAK'S PROPOSED RATE**
16 **DESIGN?**

17 A. No. Although Mr. Novak does not discuss his methodology, he lays out his
18 proposed rate design on Table 6 of his testimony. This rate design is against the
19 Approved Methodologies as it seeks to shift more of the proposed rate deficiency

1 to volumetric charges rather than base charges across various rate schedules.

2 **Q. WHAT DOES THE COMPANY PROPOSE AS ITS RATE DESIGN?**

3 A. The Company's proposed rate design in on Schedule 11-3 of WDM-R-1. Although
4 the difference is relatively minor compared to Mr. Novak's proposal, the
5 Company's proposed rate design is done in accordance with the Approved
6 Methodologies in the allocation of the revenue deficiency between base and
7 volumetric charges across the rate schedules.⁷

8 **Q. TURNING TO THE FINAL PROPOSED ADJUSTMENT, DOES THE**
9 **COMPANY AGREE WITH MR. NOVAK'S PROPOSED "OTHER**
10 **MISCELLANEOUS ADJUSTMENTS" RECOMMENDATION?**

11 A. No. The Company believes that the miscellaneous adjustment of (\$1,009) proposed
12 by Mr. Novak does not have any supporting details and therefore should not be
13 included. Due to the small amount, the Company believes that an adjustment along
14 these lines would be updated and ultimately included within the final revenue
15 requirement model that results from this proceeding.

16 **Q. PER THE COMPANY'S EXHIBIT WDM-R-1, WHAT IS THE COMPANY'S**

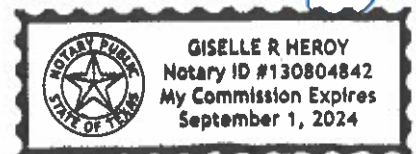
