To assist the Commission in its ongoing investigation of the ongoing docket, it is requested that the following information be provided.

- 1. <u>Regarding Commission Rule 1220-04-13-.17(2)(a)(7):</u> The maps provided with the petition are not readable due to being blurry. Please provide readable maps identifying drip field areas, treatment facilities, and roads to access the associative parcel.
- 2. <u>Regarding Commission Rule 1220-04-13-.17(2)(b)(1):</u> Provide a letter from the Bedford County government regarding its intent/non-intent to provide service to this development.
- 3. <u>Regarding Commission Rule 1220-04-13-.17(2)(b)(3):</u> Provide a copy of the construction agreement for the wastewater system.
- 4. <u>Regarding Commission Rule 1220-04-13-.17(2)(c)(4):</u> Provide a copy of a valid contractor's license for the contractor that is being utilized to build the wastewater system. If the designated contractor will remain Adenus Solutions Group, LLC, disregard this question.
- 5. <u>Regarding Commission Rule 1220-04-13-.17(2)(d)(1):</u> Provide a letter from TDEC indicating receipt of a complete SOP application for this project. In addition, if a draft permit has been issued, provide a copy.
- 6. Regarding Commission Rule 1220-04-13-.17(2)(d)(4): A list of any complaint(s), notices of violation or administrative action filed with or issued by a regulatory agency. Identify the

nature of the complaint notices of violation or administrative action, which agency is involved, and how the issue was or is being resolved.

- 7. Although the following information has been provided, it is requested that the company refile the following as non-confidential.
 - A. Exhibit14, Sanitary Sewer Service Agreement including all attachments; and
 - B. Exhibit 31, Five year Buildout Estimate of Development; and

Should the Company refuse to lift the confidentiality of any requested item, Staff respectfully requests that the Company provide a legal brief and/or detailed explanations as to why such items should be treated as confidential.
