I, Jeffrey Ansted, President of American Broadband and Telecommunications Company LLC (“American Broadband”), hereby state upon oath and affirmation of belief and personal knowledge (1) that the statements in the Petition are true to the best of my knowledge and belief and (2) that the following statement is true to the best of my knowledge and belief.

- Section 254(e) of the Act provides that, “only an eligible telecommunications carrier designated under section 214(e) shall be eligible to receive specific federal universal service support.”
- Section 214(e)(2) of the Act authorizes state commissions, such as the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“Commission”), to designate ETC status for federal universal service purposes and authorizes the Commission to designate wireless ETCs.<sup>1</sup>
- Section 214(e)(1) of the Act and Section 54.201(d) of the FCC’s rules provide that applicants for ETC designation must be common carriers that shall, throughout the designated service area, offer all of the services supported by universal service, either using their own facilities or a combination of their own facilities and the resale of another carrier’s services, except where the FCC has forbore from the “own facilities” requirement.
- Applicants must also commit to advertise the rates of such services.<sup>2</sup>
