Dear Chairman Hilliard:

In response to the Consumer Advocate's Motion for Leave to Issue More Than Forty Discovery Requests (the "Motion"), Tennessee-American Water Company ("TAWC" or "Company") does not object to the Consumer Advocate Division's ("Consumer Advocate" or "CAD") June 7th request to issue approximately 250 total discovery requests, including subparts, to TAWC.¹ Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Company reserves its right to object to the number of future requests by the CAD in this docket. The Company does not interpret the CAD's request as open-ended or a request for an unlimited number of future discovery requests, but rather as a request to issue the June 7th discovery requests. In the unlikely event the Commission interprets the Motion as open-ended, TAWC hereby respectfully requests the opportunity to formally object to the Motion.

Finally, the Company reserves its right to object to future requests by the CAD to serve additional written discovery in this docket. To the extent the CAD intends to serve additional requests, TAWC invites the Consumer Advocate to meet and confer to determine whether such additional discovery can be streamlined or reduced.
