The hearing in the above-captioned matter (the “Hearing”) is set by the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“TPUC” or the “Commission”) to begin on November 18, 2024 at 10:00 a.m. (CST) through November 21, 2024, in Conference Room G.201 located on the Ground Floor of the Andrew Jackson State Office Building, 500 Deaderick Street, Nashville, Tennessee 37243.

Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. 4-5-312(c), the Utility Workers Union of America, AFL-CIO, and UWUA Local 121 (the “Intervenor”) submits this Motion to Appear and Participate at Hearing Electronically (the “Motion”) and provides the following in support of this Motion:

Tenn. Code Ann. § 4-5-312(c) addresses electronic participation at a hearing as follows:

In the discretion of the administrative judge or hearing officer and agency members and by agreement of the parties, all or part of the hearing may be conducted by telephone, television or other electronic means, if each participant in the hearing has an opportunity to participate in, to hear, and, if technically feasible, to see the entire proceedings while taking place.

In accordance with the above-referenced statute, Intervenor hereby respectfully requests that its witness, Shawn Garvey, be allowed to participate in the Hearing electronically on Tuesday, November 19, 2024, because the Hearing has proceeded more rapidly than expected as compared to

the Parties' pre-Hearing estimated times for cross examination. Mr. Garvey is in New York until late afternoon on Tuesday, November 19, 2024, when he will then fly to Nashville. Mr. Garvey had expected to testify in person on the morning of Wednesday, November 20, 2024, but the pace of the Hearing as of the filing of this Motion suggests that the Hearing could conclude today, on November 19, 2024.
