ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO DISMISS APPLICATION

This matter is before the Administrative Judge of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (the “Commission” or “TPUC”) upon a *Motion to Dismiss Application* filed by Frontier Fiber Venture, LLC (“Frontier,” “Applicant,” or “Company”) on September 12, 2024. The Applicant states that it desires to withdraw the application submitted by the Company. Frontier has represented that it has been acquired by another provider and as a result no longer desires to proceed with its application to provide competing telecommunication service.

The Administrative Judge finds that the *Motion to Dismiss Application* is well taken and should be granted.
