Greetings. After several phone calls, I found the following water rate information from surrounding communities. Not all, but several. First off, none of these cities have nonmetered water users so direct comparisons to Candlewood Lakes is difficult.

Bolivar Utility. \$18.14/mo on the first 2000 gallons.

Grand Junction Water. \$21.50/mo on the first 2000 gallons.

Middleton Water. \$16.40/mo on the first 1000 gallons.

Whiteville Water. \$40.40/mo with no minimum.

I do not believe that my wife and I use over 2000 gallons of water monthly. We'll never know without a meter. Regardless, at \$40/mo I feel we are overpaying by the gallon and \$67.50/mo would be outlandish.

Since Limestone took over our water system, the water does not taste any better nor has our water pressure improved. What is the end game?
