Greetings. I attended the public forum meeting at Pickwick Landing last night. First, thanks to all state of Tennessee associates who were there. The attendance was large and forced the lodge staff to remodel our conference room on the fly.

The most prominent feelings were confusing and frustration. Folks were confused as to what Limestone was asking for and where their requests for rate increases were conceived. People were frustrated as Limestone blindsided all its customers with no prior notification of their intentions. The majority of attendees stated that Limestone had not earned any of the increases. Personally, the rate increase for water is 68%, but I heard of increases at the 400, 500, and 600% level. Sadly, my income will not increase 60%, yet alone 600. Limestone Water UOC has done a serviceable job of operating systems across its network in Tennessee, but a terrible job of communicating with its customers and being open and transparent.

In my humble opinion, the Tennessee Public Utility Commission has no reason to approve any of Limestone's requests.
