The Tennessee Public Utility Commission ("Commission" or "TPUC") is seeking comment from members of the public regarding the Petition for a general rate increase, which was filed on July 16, 2024, by Limestone Water Utility Operating Company, LLC ("Limestone").

The Commission will hold a public meeting in Nashville, TN to hear comments from the public regarding Limestone's Petition. This public meeting will be held on **Thursday, February 13, 2025, from 3:00 p.m. (CST) to 6:00 p.m. (CST)** in **Hearing Room G.201** on the Ground Floor of the Andrew Jackson State Office Building, 500 Deaderick Street, Nashville, TN. Commission officials will preside over the public meeting, and members of the public are invited to attend and present comments. Further, the Commission will hold a hearing on the merits of Limestone's Petition and hear testimony from witnesses to determine whether the requested rate increase, or any part thereof, should be approved. The hearing on the merits will be held in Hearing Room G.201 of the Andrew Jackson State Office Building, 500 Deaderick Street, Nashville, TN, on February 18, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. (CST). The public will also have an opportunity to offer comments during this hearing.
