The proposed rate increase in the Shiloh Falls Residential area from \$20.03 to \$86.64/3000 gallons is totally unacceptable and uncalled for. The proposal represents a 432% price increase. I am sure profit is the motivation and Limestone sees an opportunity since they in fact have a monopoly on the water supply in the subdivision. Had they effectively conducted due diligence before closing on the transaction, they certainly could have understood the economics of owning the water company.
